About the Speaker: Morris McCain, EBTRON Sales Manager

Morris McCain spent his entire HVAC career at EBTRON.

He has previously presented at numerous ASHRAE meetings around the country and several regional NEBB meetings and has given over 2000 presentations on Indoor Air Quality.

In 1993 Morris graduated Summa Cum Laude at High Point University with a double major in Business Administration and Computer Information Systems and has been the Sales Manager at EBTRON for the past 10 years.

EBTRON has been a leader in air flow measurement for more than 27 years. The company started in Peapack, NJ in 1983 and started producing its analog TAMS (Thermistor Air Measuring System) at that time. EBTRON introduced the first microprocessor-based thermal dispersion airflow measurement device in 1986. The new "Digital EBTRON revolutionized thermal dispersion technology by overcoming the non-linearity and temperature compensation shortcomings associated with other thermal flow meters.
